Agenda Item 2: Organisation of the Meeting

Purpose of paper

1. To explain the rules of procedure for the conduct of the meeting of the Conference of the Parties to the Noumea Convention and to elect officers.

Background

2. The Rules of Procedure of the Noumea Convention apply to the meeting in accordance with Article 22 of the Convention. Copies may be obtained from <https://www.sprep.org/convention-secretariat/noumea-convention>.
3. Rule 20 of the Rules of Procedure states that at the commencement of the first session of each Ordinary Meeting, a Chairperson and a Vice Chairperson are to be elected from among the representatives of the Contracting Parties by a simple majority vote. There are 12 Parties to the Convention: Australia, Cook Islands, Federated States of Micronesia, Fiji, France, Marshall Islands, Nauru, New Zealand, Papua New Guinea, Samoa, Solomon Islands, and the United States of America.
